



Michigan Legislation 2023-2024

Updated April 9, 2024



House Bills

HB 4006 Abortion (Pohutsky)

SUMMARY: Repeals penalty for administering with intent to procure miscarriage.

ACTIVITY: Signed by the Governor (4/5/2023; Effective date: 90 days after the sine die adjournment of the Legislature)

HB 4071 Chemotherapy (Steckloff)

SUMMARY: Provides equal treatment for coverage for orally administered anticancer chemotherapy.

ACTIVITY: Presented in House (10/17/2023; Presented 10/17/2023)

HB 4120 (PA 46) Child Protection (Rogers)

SUMMARY: Requires distribution of training package to individuals designated as mandatory reporters for child abuse or child neglect.

ACTIVITY: Signed by the Governor (6/29/2023; Signed: June 29, 2023, Effective: September 26, 2023)

HB 4362 (PA 100) Anatomical Gifts (Brabec)

SUMMARY: Provides opt-in option for individuals to participate in organ donor registry when filing taxes.

ACTIVITY: Signed by the Governor (7/19/2023; Signed: July 19, 2023, Effective: July 19, 2023)

HB 4363 (PA 101) Anatomical Gifts (Neeley)

SUMMARY: Allows inclusion on the donor registry of an individual who elects to be a donor on an income tax schedule

ACTIVITY: Signed by the Governor (7/19/2023; Signed: July 19, 2023, Effective: July 19, 2023)

HB 4620 (PA 157) Health Insurers (Edwards)

SUMMARY: Prohibits denying coverage for preexisting conditions and prohibits canceling coverage based on health of insured

ACTIVITY: Signed by the Governor (10/19/2023; Signed: October 19, 2023, Effective: 90 days after sine die)

HB 4621 (PA 158) Health Insurers (Fitzgerald)

SUMMARY: Requires coverage for dependents under the age of 26.

ACTIVITY: Signed by the Governor (10/19/2023; Signed: October 19, 2023, Effective: 90 days after sine die)

HB 4622 (PA 159) Health Insurers (Miller)

SUMMARY: Prohibits annual and lifetime dollar limits.

ACTIVITY: Signed by the Governor (10/19/2023; Signed: October 19, 2023, Effective: 90 days after sine die)

HB 4623 (PA 160) Health Insurers (Koleszar)

SUMMARY: Provides minimum required coverage.

ACTIVITY: Signed by the Governor (10/19/2023; Signed: October 19, 2023, Effective: 90 days after sine die)

Senate Bills

SB 2 Abortion (Geiss)


SUMMARY: Repeals provision related to publication of cures for conceptive preventatives.

ACTIVITY: Signed by the Governor (4/5/2023; Effective: 90 days after the sine die adjournment of the Legislature)

SB 71 (PA 62) Medical Records (Hauck)

SUMMARY: Implements provision for the protection, retention, and maintenance of medical records referencing a vaginal or anal penetration treatment for 15 years by a health professional and health facility or agency and requires certain boards to provide guidance to licensees on medical services involving vaginal or anal penetration.

ACTIVITY: Signed by the Governor (7/12/2023; Signed: July 11, 2023, Effective: October 9, 2023)



House Bills

HB 4131 Health Insurers (Liberati)

SUMMARY: Modifies coverage for health care services provided through telemedicine.

ACTIVITY: Passed House. Reported in Senate (3/13/2024; S-2 substitute adopted.; By Health Policy Committee)

Senate Bills

SB 37 Abortion (Bayer)

SUMMARY: Removes reference to crime of administering drugs to procure miscarriage to reflect repeal.

ACTIVITY: Passed in Senate (3/8/2023; 20-18; Earlier advanced to Third Reading)

SB 39 Abortion (Anthony)

SUMMARY: Repeals penalty for administering with intent to procure miscarriage. **ACTIVITY:** Passed in Senate (3/8/2023; 20-18; Earlier advanced to Third Reading)

SB 483 Pharmaceuticals (Camilleri)

SUMMARY: Creates prescription drug cost and affordability review act.

ACTIVITY: Passed in Senate (10/4/2023; 20-17)

SB 484 Health Insurers (Klinefelt)

SUMMARY: Requires compliance with the prescription drug cost and affordability review act.

ACTIVITY: Passed in Senate (10/4/2023; 20-17)

SB 485 Medical Services (McDonald Rivet)

SUMMARY: Requires compliance with the prescription drug cost and affordability review act.

ACTIVITY: Passed in Senate (10/4/2023; 20-17)

SB 44 Health Testing (Wojno)

SUMMARY: Prohibits invasive bodily examinations under certain circumstances.

ACTIVITY: Passed in Senate (11/8/2023; 35-0; Earlier advanced to 3rd Reading with committee substitute S-2 adopted.)

SB 45 Health Testing (Santana)

SUMMARY: Adds definition of invasive bodily examination.

ACTIVITY: Passed in Senate (11/8/2023; 35-0; Earlier advanced to Third Reading.)

House Resolutions

HR 10 Month Designation (Prestin)

SUMMARY: A resolution to declare January 2023 as Fire Fighter Cancer Awareness Month in the state of Michigan.

ACTIVITY: Passed in House (1/12/2023; Voice Vote)

HR 40 Date Designation (Conlin)

SUMMARY: A resolution to declare February 15, 2023, as Less Cancer Day in the state of Michigan.

ACTIVITY: Passed in House (2/28/2023; Voice Vote)

Senate Resolutions

SR 23 Month Designation (Hertel, K.)

SUMMARY: A resolution to recognize March 2023 as Colorectal Cancer Awareness Month.

ACTIVITY: Passed in Senate (3/23/2023; Voice Vote)



House Bills

HB 4409 Pharmaceuticals (Steckloff)

SUMMARY: Requires manufacturers of prescription drugs to file with the department reports on certain costs and other information associated with prescription drugs.

ACTIVITY: Reported in House (5/11/2023; By Health Policy Committee)

Senate Bills

SB 38 Abortion (Chang)

SUMMARY: Removes reference to crime of administering drugs to procure miscarriage to reflect repeal.

ACTIVITY: Re-referred in Senate (4/26/2023; To Health Policy Committee)

House Bills

HB 4174 Month Designation (Miller)

SUMMARY: Designates "Cervical Cancer Awareness Month" as the month of January of each year.

ACTIVITY: Introduced (3/2/2023)

HB 4434 Health Insurance (Stone)

SUMMARY: Requires coverage of health insurers for dispensing a 90-day refill for maintenance prescription drug.

ACTIVITY: Introduced (4/19/2023; To Health Policy Committee)

HB 5062 Pediatric Cancer (O'Neal)

SUMMARY: Creates pediatric cancer fund act.

ACTIVITY: Referred in House (1/18/2024; To Health Policy Committee)

HB 5084 Breast Cancer (Carter, B.)

SUMMARY: Provides coverage for examinations and medications related to breast cancer.

ACTIVITY: Introduced (10/4/2023; To Insurance and Financial Services Committee)

HB 5416 Occupations - Medical Assistants (Liberati)

SUMMARY: Establishes licensure for medical assistants.

ACTIVITY: Introduced (1/30/2024; To Health Policy Committee)

SUMMARY: Establishes licensure for medical assistants.
